The hospital will have provision of ICU , CCU, NICU & PICU, Radiotherapy, Chemotherapy, Physiotherapy, Family Planning & Immunization, DOTS Clinic and special clinics for Diabetes, Liver, Heart and Lung diseases.

E. Capacity-Building Plan

MMIMS with its internal fund and academic partnership with international institutions will provide the various capacity building activities to its faculties and staff members. MMIMS intends to develop linkages with national and international institutions for its extension programs. MMIMS will develop relations with the health organizations for in-plant training programs.

F. Research And Development

The MMIMS intends to start a Research, Training and International relation wing with the necessary infrastructures and facilities. It will conduct research in clinical and all health domains and periodically publish academic journals. Moreover, MMIMS will support government health institutions to develop their academic capacities.

10.FACILITIES FOR SHARE MEMBER OF MMIMS

- Share Member and his/her spouse and family members will get 20% discount in available services of the hospital.
- Share Members and their family members will get 30% discount for complete health checkup once a year.
- Share Member and their children will get 10% discount in monthly fee if they study in Manmohan Memorial Institute of Health Sciences (MMIHS).
- Share Member and their children will get 10% discount in total admission fee if they study MBBS in Manmohan Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences (MMIMS).
- A Share Member Relief Fund (SMRF) will be established. The Share Member will be provided minimum Rs. 20,000 (NRs. twenty thousand only) or 15% of the total share amount if they suffered from grievous situation like renal transplantation surgery, valve replacement surgery, cancer and cerebro-vascular accident (CVA).
- MMIMS will provide Rs. 25,000 each (NRs. twenty-five thousand only) to two SLC topper students of Share Member (one girl and one boy) every year.
- Every year NEHCO will arrange an observation tour and provide Rs. 5,000 (NRs. five thousand only) each to hundred Share Member as traveling allowance to study the activities of other co-operatives of the country.
- Insurance will be done for each Share Member so that Rs. 200,000 (NRs. two hundred thousand only) will be provided in case of death from accident of any origin and Rs. 100,000 (NRs. one hundred thousand only) will be provided in case of usual death of the Share Member.

1. BACKGROUND

The health indicators of Nepal are embarrassing. Poverty, malnutrition, ignorance, deep rooted traditional beliefs, unmanaged urbanization and deteriorating environmental conditions are the major factors affecting health of Nepalese people. In these circumstances, **Nepal Health Care Co-operative Limited (NEHCO)** is founded on 17 March, 2006 under which a 100 bedded **Manmohan Memorial Community Hospital** and **Manmohan Memorial Institute of Health Sciences (MMIHS)** are established in the year 2006 and 2007 respectively. Both wings are established under the name of **Former Prime Minister Late Manmohan Adhikari**, a great patriot and legendary leader of Nepal.

In line with thinking of **Center of Excellence** with purpose of providing quality medical education, health service delivery and health research, **Manmohan Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences (MMIMS)** is established under NEHCO which is committed to invest its all efforts to fulfill the purpose through co-operative initiatives. **MMIMS** is established by a group of academicians, researchers, industrialists and prominent professionals with extensive exposure to a wide range of innovative knowledge, experience and teaching/learning practices.

2. ACHIEVEMENTS TO DATE

- About 1500 NEHCO Share Members.
- Design of Hospital and Academic Building is completed.
- Project proposal is prepared.
- Soil test of construction site is accomplished.
- Running a well equipped 100 bedded Hospital at Thamel.
- 24 ropanis (12207.36 sq. meters) land is bought at Swoyambhu for the construction of teaching hospital.
- 75 ropanis (38148.00 sq. meters) land is bought for academic building and hostel at Thankot.
- A four storeyed building and another two storeyed building in 5245.35 sq. meter land are purchased at Nakhkhu, Lalitpur.
- Letter of Intent (LOI) has been received to establish medical college (MMIMS) from Ministry of Education.
- Strong pool of national and international human resources.
- Ten years academic master plan is made.
- Academic health programs –B.Sc. Nursing, Post basic Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Public health, PCL Nursing, HA, PCL Lab are being run.
- EIA report for building construction is being prepared.

3. LOCATION

The Teaching Hospital is located at Swoyambhu adjacent to the ring road whereas the Medical College academic building will be located at Thankot around 8 km west from the Swoyambhu Teaching Hospital.

4. RATIONALE

- The enormous demand of qualified medical graduates in Nepal and in developed world as compelling evidence to make our investment in medical college.
- The need of Teaching Hospital to provide advance medical services to the patients through qualified medical professionals.

- Excellent academic environment to attract international students and faculties.
- Substantial income from highly sophisticated Teaching Hospital & Research Centre to sustain the project.
- The need of an international standard health institute to offer an academic yard for both local and foreign students, addressing foreign out flow of large number of students seeking medical education.

5. VISION

To upgrade quality of life of Nepalese people through the provision of quality medical service, education and research.

6. MISSION

To promote the quality health services through equity in service delivery, social inclusion in health program planning and health service utilization and production of competent human resources also from marginalized groups and remote areas of Nepal.

7. GOAL

To develop MMIMS as **A CENTER OF EXCELLENCE THROUGH EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND SERVICE.**

8. OBJECTIVES

- a. To produce quality health manpower.
- b. To provide 24 hours general, speciality and emergency curative services at affordable cost.
- c. To produce health professionals competent to take a lead in planning, organizing, delivering and evaluating health policy & health services within the country and abroad.
- d. To support the national health policy and other health related commitments of the Government.
- e. To conduct participatory and community based research related to pharmacy, nursing, public health, medicine and other clinical disciplines.
- f. To establish & promote community hospitals and health clinics in different parts of the country.
- g. To ensure understanding, co-ordination and mutual

- co-operation with national and international institutions in relation to academic knowledge, skill and training.
- h. To launch package Health Services and Health Insurance Schemes for individuals, professionals, communities, schools, colleges, organizations and target groups.
 - i. To launch health related community programs and projects e.g. child and maternal health programs, HIV/AIDS prevention programs, family planing programs and free health camps etc.

9. FUTURE PLAN

A. Academic

MMIMS will start MBBS program by 2012 February session.

The MMIMS will have academic buildings and hostels as per guidelines of Nepal medical council. The college will have departments of Clinical Biochemistry, Clinical Pharmacology, Human Anatomy, Clinical Physiology, Community Medicine, Medical Microbiology and Pathology besides all clinical departments in the hospital.

Upon successful operation of 5 years, the MMIMS will start BDS and Postgraduate Programs (MD/ MS) & MSc. in Human Anatomy, Clinical Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology and Forensic Medicine and other clinical disciplines. Furthermore, MMIMS will initiate building up Community Satellite Health Centers and Hospitals in different parts of the country and develop Supper Speciality Health Care and Research Centers in different clinical disciplines as well as Super Speciality Academic Programs of Doctoral levels. NEHCO has planned to establish **Manmohan Adhikari Co-operative University.**

MMIMS will have well furnished and well managed library with adequate books, international journals and magazines.

B. Hospital Services

- i. Advance imaging and diagnostic center

An ultramodern and latest CT scan and MRI devices will be made available through which whole body scan can be possible within few seconds so that Nepalese People don't have to go abroad for proper diagnosis and treatment. In addition the hospital will have the following diagnostic services:

- All types of X-ray with 500 MA Machine (CR), IVU, Barium meal/ follow through etc., ERCP, HSG, Cholangiography, ECG, Echocardiography, TMT, EEG, Mammography, Bronchoscopy, Spirometry, Audiometry, Gastro-Endoscopy & Colonoscopy.
- Color doppler Ultrasound for all parts of body. EMG (Electroencemyography), Pulmonary function tests etc.
- Laboratory: Microbiology, Biochemistry, Histopathology & Cytology, Immunology, Hematology, Virology & Serology
- Transplant Immunology and Immunogenetics



- ii. OPD services: Special and general out patient services for all diseases
- iii. Emergency: 24 hours quality emergency services
- iv. Blood Bank: 24 hours blood bank services
- v. Indoor services:

A 700 bedded well furnished indoor services comprising free beds, general beds, double bed cabins and single bed deluxe cabins in Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Orthopedics, Pediatrics, ENT, Psychiatry,
