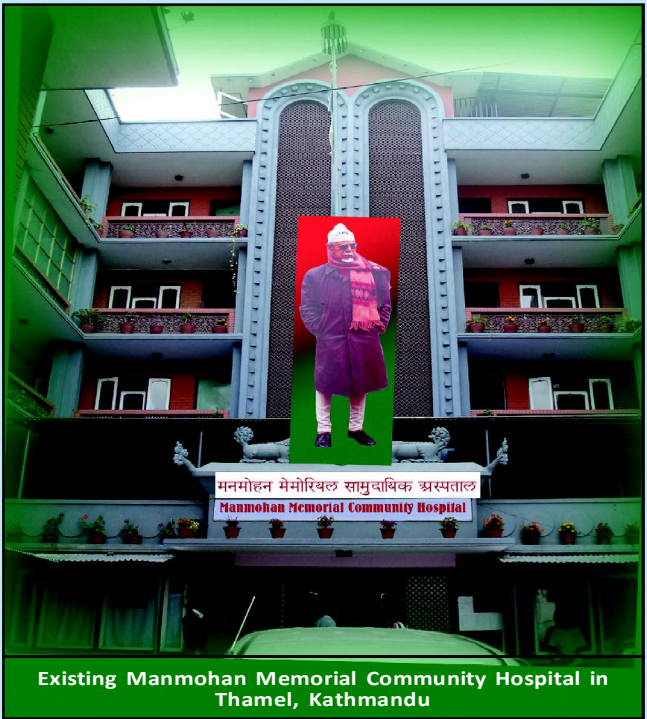


Mahayangya for Construction of Manmohan Memorial Community Hospital

Background

Health indicators of Nepal are embrassing due to the lack of resources, poor distribution mechanism, deep rooted traditional beliefs etc. Nepal is a country having high maternal mortality ratio and high infant mortality rate. Many people of Nepal die of malnutrition, famine, dehydration and many infectious diseases. Health service facilities in the country and even in the capital Kathmandu are yet far beyond the reach of poor and middle economic class people. There is a distinct gap and discrepancy that has created unmanageable load on to the Government hospitals and health institutions. In this context, a 100 bedded Manmohan Memorial Community Hospital (MMCH) was established in a rented building in Thamel to make Ex. Prime Minister late Manmohan Adhikari's contribution beyond the bounds of memory, and provide quality health services to the needy people at affordable cost. Founded in 2006, MMCH has run



academic programmes in Manmohan Memorial Institute of Health Sciences (MMIHS). Manmohan Memorial Medical College, which is one of the major wings, has obtained **letter of intent** from Ministry of Education in the year 2007. A proposed University named as Manmohan Adhikari Cooperative University is also under the process of establishment. With a view to promote our motto "Hospital for All" MMCH, a non-profit making hospital, has provided different health facilities with latest technologies for the needy people. It has a vision to be an outstanding hospital in this region.

Why Mahayangya ?

Financial backing is the prime requirement for bringing our dream into reality. Therefore, we are obliged to seek out all possible resources available. In this view, we are inclined towards mobilizing givers mass through a grand as well as holy ceremony of Mahayangya commencing from 31st Oct. to 8th Nov. 2009. in the very premises of the proposed hospital building, at Swayambhu 15, Kathmandu. During this occasion, the organizing team has expected to collect not less than thousand million rupees from all the devotees, donors and well wishers to lead the underlying projects a grand success.

Renowned Pundit **Dinbandhu Pokharel** has kindly consented to attend the Mahayangya as the chief Pundit.

Not only this, the Yangya, being a pure religious and spiritual practice, will endorse sustainable peace and stability in the country, promote friendship and brotherhood, bring harmony in relationships and enhance mutual cooperation and understanding among the people of Nepal.

The collected fund will be utilised to make the following plans and projects successful.

- construct 700 bedded hospital with all sorts of modern technologies in its own 11444 sq. meters of land.
- open 15 bedded hospital in each 5 development regions.
- provide scholarships for the deserving students of each region to study MBBS course.

- establish a half million rupees Manmohan Memorial health fund in all districts.
- set up a fund of five million rupees for the treatment of journalists.
- create a fixed fund of five million rupees for the treatment of manual workers.
- offer free health check up facilities for the children below five years.
- provide free health check up along with fifteen beds indoor services for the senior citizens.
- develop infrastructure for Manmohan Adhikari Cooperative University.
